

VITAL STATISTICS

The following certified copies are available from the Somerville Division of Health:

- Birth certificate for anyone born at Somerset Medical Center or in the borough of Somerville.
- Death certificate for anyone who has died in the borough of Somerville.
- Marriage certificate for couples married in the borough of Somerville.

Each certified copy is \$20.00 and is payable with cash, a money order or a check made out to the Somerville Division of Health. We do not accept credit or debit cards.

Certificates can be obtained in person at the Division of Health, located at 25 West End Avenue between 8:30 AM and 4:15 PM Monday through Friday.

If you are requesting a certificate through the mail, photocopy the driver's license and include a stamped self-addressed envelope with your request, as well as the following information as it applies to the type of certificate you are requesting. Please do not send cash through the mail. Send all requests to:

As required by the New Jersey State Department of Vital Statistics:

- Only you or your mother or father, spouse, or sibling, child or grandchild if 18 years or older may obtain your birth certificate. A certificate will not be released to any other relative or family friend.
- Valid identification (ID) is required for the release of a certified copy of a vital record.
- To request a birth certificate you must know the full birth name, the exact date of birth, as well as the father's full name and the mother's maiden name.
- To request a death certificate you must know the full name, the date of death, and the exact location where the person died, such as at home or at Somerset Medical Center.
- To request a marriage certificate you must know the full names of the bride and groom, the bride's maiden name, the date and location of the wedding.
